Roy Yamaguchi Dinner Raises \$400,000 at Celebrity Fight Night Fundraiser Benefits Muhammad Ali's Parkinson Center

Phoenix, Arizona, March 24, 2007 – Roy Yamaguchi joined forces with Muhammad Ali at Celebrity Fight Night tonight to raise money for fight against Parkinson Disease.
